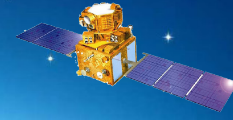
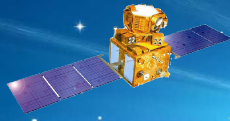




# GOLDEN JUBILEE CELEBRATION OF ISRS AND JISRS

Established in 1969 as the "Indian Society of Photo-interpretation" with a not-for-profit scientific society, the main objectives remained towards advancement and dissemination of remote sensing with conventional methods in the field of survey, planning, and management of natural resources and the environment through organizing seminars/symposia and by publishing journal, bulletins, proceedings, etc. From its modest beginning with 56 members, the Society has grown into a premier professional body with a membership of more than 5900, including both individual and Institutional members.
